## HOW TO FORM YOUR COLLEGE LIST

- 1. Limit your college list to
  4-6 colleges
  a. Application fees are
  expensive and each
  application needs your
  time and attention to
  be of high quality
- 2. Visit the colleges you are considering
- 3. Compare your SAT/ACT scores and GPA to the school's expectations a. Reach vs. Target vs.

  Safety
- 4. Use tools such as College
  Board and College
  Greenlight to search for schools

#### HOW TO APPLY

- Once you have your list, write down everything you need (transcripts, essays, recommendations, etc.)
- 2. Load everything into Naviance by October 1st
  - a. Ms. Gaudette will be making individualized checklists for all seniors based on what is in Naviance
- 3. Figure out how you will apply to each school on your list: CommonApp, Coalition, School Website
- 4. Write drafts of your essays and have them looked over by a trusted adult or teacher.
  - a. Ms. Gaudette will do last reviews between now and October 1


## HOW TO APPLY (CONTINUED)

#### RECOMMENDATION LETTERS

\*Have you asked your teachers yet? If not, you're super behind. Teachers must be added into Naviance by October 1st. Ask your teachers to upload their letters by October 15th so that you don't miss your deadlines!

by October 1st

## HOW TO APPLY (CONTINUED)



#### Transcript Requests

\*If you are applying through Naviance,
I will send your transcript and letters
through there with no paperwork needed.

\*If a school requires a transcript to be mailed, Naviance will have a symbol that looks like a Red Stamp. For those schools, you will need to fill out a Transcript Request Form and turn it in to Ms. Gaudette With a blank, unstamped envelope.

\*Ms. Gaudette will prepare a mailer for each of those schools for you to pick up and mail out.

SAT and ACT

- Most colleges require the SAT or the ACT.
- 2. Sign up for the
  October and/or
  November test if you
  want to boost your
  scores a little bit
  more!
  - a. Register for the SAT on the CollegeBoard website and pay the fee online.
- 3. \*\*Community Colleges

  do NOT require the SAT

  or ACT, but they

  sometimes use it for

academic placement.
