WHAT HAPPENS NEXT? You will be notified to submit a 3-5 minute video of you

performing, or explaining about your art project, or reading your literary piece. Your submission must be based on the theme, "Celebrating African American Heritage through the Arts". Your recording will be viewed and if selected, will

appear in the Showcase.

WHAT COULD I RECEIVE? Students selected to participate in the Showcase will receive a

monetary honorarium & certificate of appreciation. They will also become eligible to participate in the on-going A.R.T. S Mentoring Program to receive continued support to enhance

their artistic growth and development.
