<b>January</b> TESTING WINDOW January 7- February 8	Identified students Grades K-5	ACCESS for ELLs (English Language Proficiency Test) This paper/pencil and online assessment measures English language proficiencies in the areas of reading, writing, listening and speaking.
<b>January</b> January 7-11	2-5	NWEA MAP- Reading This is an online, adaptive assessment that efficiently measures oral reading fluency, comprehension, and foundational skills.
<b>January</b> January 14-18	K-5	NWEA MAP- Mathematics This is an online, adaptive assessment that efficiently measures number sense, estimation and computation, geometry, measurement, and problem solving.
<b>January</b> TESTING WINDOW January 7- February 8	K-2	Early Literacy Assessment- (DRA) This test provides teachers with immediate information for instructional decision making and indicates the direction of future teaching in reading.
<b>January</b> TESTING WINDOW January 29- February 15	5	FAST #2- Formative Assessment System Testing This formative assessment will measure student mastery of the concepts that have been taught in Science to date.
