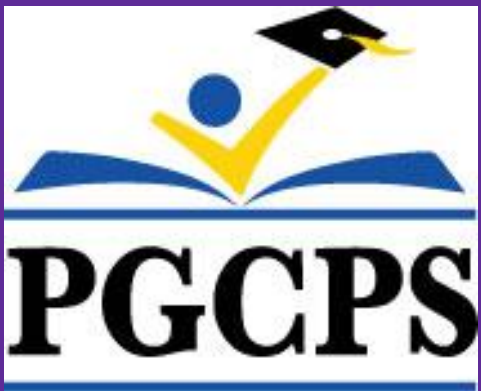
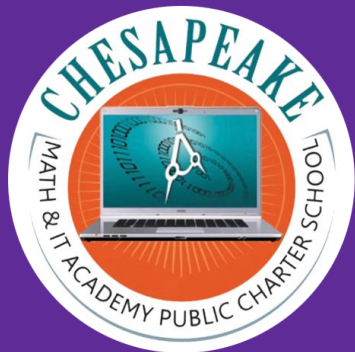

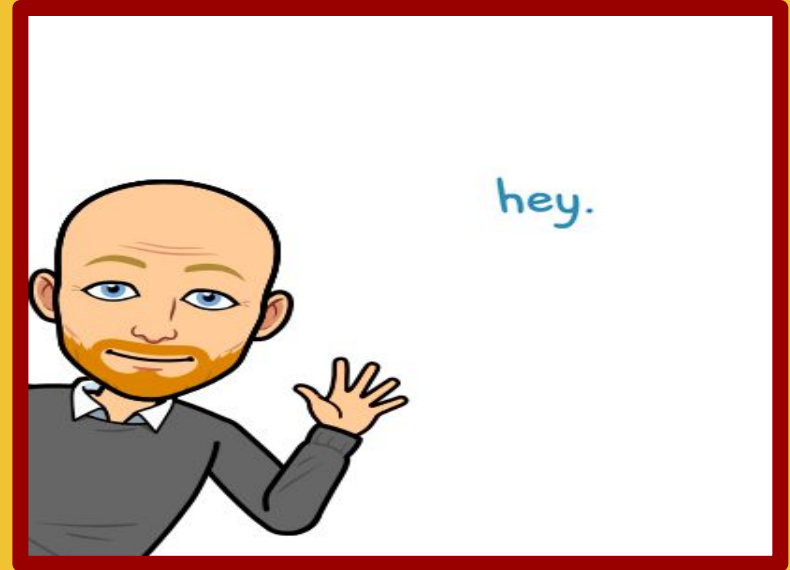

Health Services Updates

There will be two rooms available for student health

1. CARE Room (COVID Assessment Room (CARE))
2. Well Room (Non COVID health matters)
 - CARE Room
 - Students exhibiting COVID-like symptoms will be brought to the CARE Room for evaluation by the School Nurse.
 - Parents will be notified to pick student up directly from CARE Room.
 - Well Room
 - Students with non-COVID concerns such as injury, medication needs, or chronic illnesses on file with the school nurse will report to the Well Room for care.

Health Services (Cont.)

Responding to COVID-19 Concerns

- Staff and students with COVID-19 like symptoms will be immediately separated from others and taken to the CARE Room for evaluation by the School Nurse.
 - Students who are sick **must** go home.
 - Areas used by the sick person/s will be closed off, cleaned, and disinfected.
 - Students and staff must get a COVID-19 negative test in order to return to the building.
 - Students and staff that get a positive COVID-19 test must stay home until cleared by the primary care provider.
 - Notification will be sent home to inform parents and staff of possible exposure.

Health Services (Cont.)

School Personal Protective Equipment

- All students, staff, and teachers are asked to bring their own face coverings each day.
 - Additional masks will be available if needed.
- Additionally PPE will be available to staff that work in high contact positions.
 - Nurse, Food and Nutrition staff, Reception, etc.

Non-PGCPS approved cleaners and disinfectants can be brought into the school.

- Personal hand sanitizer bottles are permissible.

Facility Updates

The following preparations to the facilities have been made:

- Hand sanitizer dispensers in each classroom and office;
- All water fountains turned off;
- Six month supply of hand sanitizer, hand soap, paper towels, and disinfectant;
 - Supplied through September 2021
- Signage for:
 - Social Distancing, Mandatory Mask Wearing, Hand Washing, Out of Service Drinking Fountain.
- MERV-13 filters installed in HVAC per CDC Guidelines
- HVAC outside air intake increased
- Barriers installed at all reception and point of sale locations

Facility Updates (Cont.)

- Electrostatic Sprayer and Backpack Sprayer



Facility Updates (Cont.)

- Building Supervisor will complete routine Check Sheet for the following:
 - All designated restroom fixtures operational
 - Monitor inventory of cleaning and disinfectant supplies
 - Monitor inventory of toilet paper, hand soap, hand sanitizer, and paper towels
 - Monitor routine disinfection and cleaning procedures by custodial team.



Instruction (Cont.)

Classroom Configuration

- Classrooms will only have the number of student desks needed, not to exceed 13.
- Student desks will be arranged to be 6 feet apart, at minimum.
- Student desks will be placed near an electrical supply to ensure chromebook charging is available.
- Student desks will be supplied with a plastic barrier.





Food and Nutrition

Breakfast will be available each morning.

- Boxed breakfast will be brought to the classroom for students to eat.

Lunch will be available each day.

- Boxed lunch will be brought to the classroom for students to eat.



Instruction

What will In-Person learning look like?

- Students must be dropped off between 7:30am - 8:00am.
- Students will enter through their designated entrance by grade level.
 - Students will have a temperature check as they enter the school (non contact).
 - Students with a temperature over 100.4 degrees cannot attend school.
- Students will proceed directly to their assigned classroom.
 - Students remain in the same classroom for the entire school day.
 - Teachers will travel to classrooms to provide instruction.
- Students will be provided a breakfast to be eaten in the classroom until 8:00am.
- Students will be provided a lunch to be eaten in the classroom.

Instruction (Cont.)

- Student Materials
 - School supplied Chromebook
 - Paper, Writing Utensils, Calculator (if needed for enrolled math course).
 - The same materials students are currently using at home.
 - Headphones
 - There will be no locker use.
 - All student materials and belongings will stay with the student in the assigned classroom.
 - A full water bottle. (Drinking fountains are turned off).
 - Personal face covering.
- Students must follow the PGCPS Dress Code.
- **Students do not need to wear uniforms.**

Instruction (Cont.)

Appropriate Face Coverings per CDC Guidelines

How to Select

When selecting a mask, there are many choices. Here are some do's and don'ts.

DO choose masks that



Have two or more layers of washable, breathable fabric



Completely cover your nose and mouth



Fit snugly against the sides of your face and don't have gaps



Have a nose wire to prevent air from leaking out of the top of the mask

DO NOT choose masks that



Are made of fabric that makes it hard to breathe, for example, vinyl



Have exhalation valves or vents which allow virus particles to escape



Are intended for healthcare workers, including N95 respirators

Instruction (Cont.)

Special Considerations

Gaiters & face shields



Wear a gaiter with two layers, or fold it to make two layers

Instruction (Cont.)

Mondays - Tuesdays

- Students with last names beginning with **A - J (and selected In-Person Learning)** will report to the school building.
- All other students will remain home and participate in Distance Learning.

Wednesdays

- All students will continue the current Wednesday schedule from home.

Thursdays - Fridays

- Students with last names beginning with **K - Z (and selected In-Person Learning)** will report to the school building.
- All other students will remain home and participate in Distance Learning.

Instruction (Cont.)

Households with multiple last names in both groups should contact the school to discuss schedule options.

- Families with last names in both A-J and K-Z.
- Contact the school after February 28th to discuss schedule options.

Reopening Dates to Know

April 8, 2021

- All Special Education Students return to school (That select In-Person Hybrid Learning)
- 6th grade students return to school (That select In-Person Hybrid Learning)

April 15

- 7th & 8th grade students return to school (That select In-Person Hybrid Learning)

Parent Survey

Last day to complete or change the survey is February 28, 2021.

If Distance Learning is selected the student will remain in distance learning through the remainder of the school year.
