Competition Details & Guidelines

THIS CHALLENGE IS OPEN ONLY TO CMIT SOUTH STUDENTS.

- 1. Join the CMIT 2016 classroom through Edmodo.
 - a. Get code from Computer Technology teachers
 - b. We will inform you on Edmodo how to submit work.
- 2. Participation is **free** of charge.
- 3. Videos can be in one of the below suggested categories:
 - a. What makes CMITSouth special?
 - b. How does CMITSouth help you toward meeting your goals?
- 4. Videos must be between 90 seconds 3 minutes
- 5. Videos must be in the following **formats**:

Using your own equipment, it should either be:

- a. Standard definition (720 x 576) or b. high definition (1280 x 720)
- 6. **Entries** cannot contain any inappropriate content, such as profanity or explicit images, any nudity, sexually explicit, disparaging, any trademarks, copyrighted works or other intellectual property. If entry is determined to contain such content, it will be immediately disqualified. All videos become the property of CMIT, and can be used on CMIT website or other platforms.
- 7. The **deadline** to receive the video is April 18, 2016. A panel of CMIT staff will first review entries to determine appropriateness and adherence to the evaluation rubric.
- You will be informed of the decision by CMIT before your video is posted on the CMIT YouTube Channel.
- Entries will be uploaded to CMIT's YouTube Channel for public voting from May 2nd through May 13, 2016. Click "Like" for your favorite video.
- 12. The winners will be announced by May 20th, 2016.
- 13. To receive extra credit in Spanish, videos must be in Spanish.
- 14. By posting your video, you <u>release your rights</u> to use in or on our website and possibly other media as well.
