CMIT South – Advanced Placement Agreement

AP courses are rigorous, fast-paced and are approximately equivalent to a one-semester course at the college level. The Advanced Placement program is designed to help students gain an exposure to and an appreciation of the topics about which they are passionate. Students in these courses must be motivated to pursue at a higher level than typical high school courses, including Honors-level coursework.

Each student who plans to register for an AP course should understand the requirements outlined below. These are requirements for all AP classes.

- 1. **This is a university-level course.** Assessments, projects, and grading will be much harder than other high school classes.
- 2. AP courses will move quickly. Students must complete independent readings regularly.
- 3. **Class attendance** is mandatory. Students simply MUST be in class. Missing class may result in loss of credit and/or significant extra work.
- 4. Students should be prepared to work 1-2 hours daily at home on homework.
- 5. ALL AP students must take the **AP examination** at the end of the year. A score of 3 or higher (out of 5) on this exam may result in college credit, credit would be issued by a college upon enrollment not by our high school.
- 6. Students will *potentially* be **required** to complete a **Summer Assignment** that will be distributed in June. This assignment will constitute 15-25% of the student's grade for MP1.
- 7. **Enrolling in an AP class is a commitment.** Students need to accept the challenge of working harder and will remain in their AP courses once enrolled. Counselors, administrators, and AP teachers will conference with students to help them rise to the challenge as needed.
