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6TH GRADE UNIFORM ORDERING INFORMATION

CMIT South's official uniform vendor is Anderson Minuteman Press. There will be 3 uniform sizing/ordering days at CMIT South location. The new students must come in for sizing as manufacturers' garment sizes differ depending on the material and style.

Parents will be required to sign up for a 15-minute time block in order to come in and complete the sizing/ordering process on one of the following dates:

- June 2nd 3:00 pm to 7pm,
- June 4th 9:00 am to 1pm, and
- June 15th 3:00 pm to 7pm

All 6th grade students are required to order at least

- 2 CMIT South polo shirts, choice of kelly green or royal blue: s polo shirts for \$36 to \$47 depending on sizes
- 1 CMIT South PE shirt: \$11
- 1 CMIT South White Oxford Shirt: \$19 to \$23.50 depending on size
- 1 CMIT South tie: \$7.50 for boys \$8.75 for girls
- 1 CMIT South Fleece or Windbreaker: \$30

The total cost for the minimum package will be \$103.5 to \$120.25 depending on sizes. Parents are encouraged to order additional apparel as these uniforms will be required for everyday. The orders placed on or before June 15 will be delivered to the school during the first week of August. Parents will then be able to pick up their packets from front desk. The orders that are received after June 15 will not be delivered until September.

SUMMARY OF CMIT SOUTH UNIFORM POLICY

The following is a summary of CMIT uniform policy. A full version of the policy for 15-16 academic year is available on CMIT South's website. Parents will be sent the final 2016-17 version of the policy in July.

- Students will be issued a school ID which must be worn with a lanyard at all times while the students are at school premises.
- Pants or shorts must be either medium dark khaki or solid navy blue in color. All pants and shorts must have belt loops, and a black solid belt must be worn through all the loops and fastened appropriately. Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- Skirts or skorts must also be solid navy blue or khaki in color, no shorter than knee length.
- Shorts may be worn ONLY during Summer dates: from the first day of school through October 31st and from April 1st through the last day of school.
- Shoes must be **all black** with no other color. On PE days, students may have any color tennis shoes.
- Socks: Plain navy blue, white, or black.
- Embroidered CMIT school logo is required for all top options:
 - Regular School days: North students have royal blue and orange polo shirts, South students have royal blue and kelly green polos.
 - PE days: CMIT South students have kelly green CMIT PE shirt and black SOLID shorts/sweat pants.
 - Field trip/assembly days: CMIT's white oxford shirts and tie`
 - Casual days: On the pre-announced casual days, eligible students may wear any clothing that is in compliance with the PGCPs uniform code.
