



Current 6th grade students will need the Tdap and meningitis vaccine to enter 7th grade in Fall 2017. Guess what? All children age 11 and older can get vaccinated NOW! No need to get caught in the summer rush and risk exclusion from school on the first day.

In Spring 2017, immunization clinics will be held in your child's school. You will receive a consent form in February that gives permission for your child to be vaccinated. Please look for this information with your child's February report card.
