

PGCC Dual Enrollment Application Process for Summer/Fall 2018

If students need help filling out the paperwork, I will have a session after school from 3-4:00pm on Monday, April 9th.

Step 1: Online Application

- If you are taking a PGCC course for the first time, complete the PGCC Online Admissions Application
- Indicate **Dual Enrollment SPEC.DUAL.ND** for Application Type
- You should have received an email with the Promo Code to waive your Application Fee.
- You will receive a confirmation email after you complete the application.

Step 2: Transcript Request Form

- All students are required to fill out a Transcript Request Form so that I can provide PGCC with your Official Transcript, which is required.

Step 3: SAT/ACT Scores

- If you are using your SAT/ACT scores as your eligibility. (instead of the Accuplacer), you must print out and turn in an Official Score Report from your CollegeBoard or ACT account.

Step 4: Dual Enrollment Course Application Front Page

- Fill out the top section with your name, your PGCPS student ID number, and your PGCPS email address (NOT your CMIT email address)
- If you have taken PGCC courses previously, please also write your PGCC ID number
- Check off ALL OF THE BOXES on the Application
- Parent MUST INITIAL in the two places where it asks them to do so
- Student must sign and date at the bottom
- Parent/Guardian must sign and date at the bottom

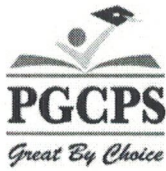
Step 5: Dual Enrollment Course Application Back Page

- Fill out the top section with your name
- If you have taken PGCC courses previously, please also write your PGCC ID number.
- Choose up to four courses from that list that indicates YOUR eligibility
 - To find the course sections and synonym numbers, follow the directions below.
 - Searching for Classes:
 - Go to www.pgcc.edu
 - Click on “Owl Link” at the top of the screen
 - Select the blue “Credit Students” button from the menu on the right
 - Scroll down and click “Additional Search Options”
 - Enter the information to search for your desired courses
- **Approved Class Example: EGL1010**
- **Section Number Example: XE01**
- **Synonym Number Example: 14356**
- If the course is on the list of courses I have provided, write “Y” in the column on the right
- Note: I recommend writing both a preferred section/synonym and alternate section/synonym just in case your preferred section is full at registration.

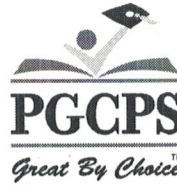
- I am aware that I must meet college requirements for dual enrollment before I am admitted to Prince George's Community College (PGCC). Additionally, I agree to allow the college to share information regarding my academic record with Prince George's County Public Schools (PGCPS) until I graduate or am no longer a registered PGCPS student.
- I am aware that I must provide my own transportation.
- I understand that I am to abide by both the PGCPS and PGCC student codes of conduct.
- I am aware that I MUST select an alternate course/section in the event my preferred course is no longer available, prior to submitting my application. I further understand, if an alternate is not selected prior to submitting the application, I may be denied the option to select a different course.
- I am aware that if approved, I will receive an email to my PGCPS email address stating that I am approved to register for courses online. It is my responsibility to register myself for courses online, in accordance with program deadlines. I may not register myself for class until I receive the approval email from MDCompletionAct@pgcc.edu.
- I am aware that I may only register for approved courses on this Dual Enrollment Application Form.
- I am aware that if I register for a course that was not approved on this form, I must submit a new Dual Enrollment Application Form to PGCC that includes the new course. If I register for any unapproved courses, I may be dropped from the course or held responsible for the cost of the course. Also, it may impact my program eligibility in the future, as well as my high school graduation eligibility if I were taking dual credit courses.
- I am aware that I must complete my registration no later than two weeks prior to the semester's first day of classes at PGCC. After that date, I must contact the PGCC Dual Enrollment Coordinator for assistance with any schedule changes.
- I understand that I am responsible for paying the cost of textbooks and applicable fees. The instructional services fee is \$48 per credit and the registration fee is \$25 per semester.* Textbook prices vary. Students who receive free and reduced meals (FARMS) will have textbooks and fees paid by PGCPS. (Parent/Guardian Initials)
- I am aware that if my child withdraws (W) or fails a dual enrollment course with an F (college/university) or E (PGCPS), I may be required to pay 90% of tuition paid by PGCPS. I further understand that my child will NOT be able to take another dual enrollment course paid by PGCPS. (Parent/Guardian Initials)
- I consent to receiving calls, including automated or prerecorded, for the purposes of receiving college-related information from Prince George's Community College. I am aware that I can revoke this consent at any time.
- I am aware that if I would like to receive academic accommodations at PGCC, I must self-identify, provide proof of disability and a paid tuition bill to PGCC's Disability Support Services (dss@pgcc.edu) at least one month prior to the start of classes.
- I understand that PGCC is prohibited from providing certain information from my student record to a third party, including parents/guardians, unless a current Consent for Access form is on file, in compliance with the Federal Family Education Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA).
