2023 COTILLION OVERVIEW

Thank you for your interest in becoming a 2023 Debutante/Beau! We are excited that the National Harbor Chapter of Jack and Jill of America, Inc. will host our 1st Cotillion Ball in 2023! We will celebrate the proud history of Jack and Jill of America, Inc. and our Debutante/Beaus.

What is Jack and Jill?

Jack and Jill of America, Inc. is the oldest non-profit African American Family Organization which encourages cultural, social, civic, and recreational activities to stimulate, expand, and enhance the lives of our children and the children in our communities. Funds raised from the ball are channeled back to the community and the Jack and Jill of America Foundation. The Debutante/Beau experience creates a lifetime of memories for participants and their families, as well as affords the Debutante/Beaus opportunities for educational awards.

What is a Debutante?

The word "Debutante/Beau" comes from the French word "débuter" which means to lead off. The Debutante/Beau tradition, as we know it in the United States, has its roots, as many of our customs do, in England.

The idea that a girl, usually of age 16, 17 or 18, should be presented to society stems from the time when a daughter of marriageable age needed to find a husband of suitable social standing. The daughters of the landed aristocracy, the lords and ladies of England, married within a very small circle and often had a very large dowry that went with them.

What is a Beau?

The objective of the Beau is to highlight our Beaus' achievements while offering meaningful educational, cultural, civic, social, and service leadership programs and activities in honor of a symbolic journey taken from adolescence to manhood. The culminating event is the Beautillion Ball, which is the formal presentation of the young men to the local community.

The 21st Century Debutante/Beau

To keep up with modern times, the themes of etiquette have now been expanded to include financial savvy, safe health practices, nutrition, self-esteem, interview skills and career planning.

This Debutante/Beau experience is intense and rewarding. It will be filled with happy memories and involves a commitment of your time, effort, and fund raising. You will meet new people and some will become lifelong friends. We encourage you to take advantage of this experience.

DEBUTANTE/BEAU CRITERIA

Throughout the Debutante/Beau experience you will interact with professionals from numerous career fields, participate in workshops, conduct a community project and be asked to an activity a month starting ----. Because of this, we require that you have the time and the ability to prioritize your school, work and other activities in order to fully participate. We would like for you to develop the attitude of "Student First – Debutante/Beau Second"

The following criteria must be met for participation in the Cotillion:

- High School Junior or Senior
- Good Character (no suspensions or history of criminal activity)
- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- Parental Agreement form signed
- Completed Application Fee and Parental Agreement form signed
- Recommendation of High School Counselor signed
- Cotillion Ball Application Fee

DEBUTANTE/BEAU WORKSHOPS AND REHEARSALS

Workshops

The self-enhancing workshops have been designed to help make your experience as a Debutante/Beau a positive learning experience and lasting memory. The workshops are designed on the premise that "you" are special and that "you" will make the most of what "you" have.

The sessions are planned as growth activities. Time will be provided for you to set goals and make short and long term plans to meet your goals. At each session, time will be allowed for the Debutante/Beau's input and evaluation. The committee only asks for 100% participation and punctuality.

Activities will include the following workshops:

- Finance Workshop
- Career/Leadership Exploration
- Health and Beauty
- Etiquette

Some workshops may include your Escorts. A schedule of dates and times will be distributed as the workshops are confirmed. If you are unable to attend a workshop, it is mandatory that you let us know at least two days prior to the workshop.

Rehearsals

A great deal of work has gone into planning and arranging rehearsals. Punctuality and regular attendance are required by all involved. Rehearsals are typically held on Sunday afternoons.

Debutante/Beaus and their escorts are expected to be present at **all** rehearsals.

Fathers (or selected substitute) will participate in one waltz with the Debutante/Beau and are expected to attend rehearsal(s) involving them.

DEBUTANTE/BEAU ATTIRE

Debutante/Beaus

Gown - White Ball Gown.

Bodice – The bodice should be well fitted without over exposure at the bust and shoulders. **No strapless**. Be sure all alterations are done prior to the Ball.

Neckline Jewel – Bateau, Sweetheart, Round (No strapless)

Sleeve Styles – Cap, Puff, Caplett. Long fitted sleeves should be avoided. 18" button length gloves will be provided.

Skirt – The skirt should be free-flowing with more than ample width at the lower edge to allow for freedom of movement. The skirt should clear the floor by one inch (1") with shoes. **Sheath and fish-tail skirts should be AVOIDED and are UNACCEPTABLE.**

Details - Special details, such as ruffles, bows and flounces add youthfulness and daintiness to garments. Utilize these details to your fullest advantage, if it suits your personality. Beads add richness to garments when tastefully applied. Use them in moderation.

Accessories

Shoes – fabric: satin, brocade, faille, leather. Shoes should complement the dress fabric.

Gloves –elbow length gloves (provided by Jack and Jill).

Jewelry – Simply one string of pearls (provided by Jack & Jill).

Matching earrings are the responsibility of the Debutante/Beau.

Mothers

All mothers will wear long, formal black gowns. Mothers will acquire their own gowns.

Fathers/Escorts

All fathers will wear black tail tuxedo. (Specifications will be given)

Escorts will wear black tuxedo. (Specifications will be given)

National Harbor Chapter of Jack and Jill will negotiate a rental rate with a Tuxedo company and all participates will be informed of the rental rate.

JACK AND JILL OF AMERICA, INC. NATIONAL HARBOR CHAPTER DEBUTANTE/BEAU PARENTAL AGREEMENT

I/We agree that my/our son /daughter is being presented as a Debutante/Beau in the 1st Cotillion Ball presented by the National Harbor Chapter of Jack and Jill of America, Inc. I/We understand that she is to attend the training sessions outlined by the Cotillion Ball Committee unless she is out of town. I/We also understand that her escort will participate in that part of the training which is designated for him. I/We also understand that the escort cannot be the Debutante/Beau's boyfriend/girlfriend. Three (3) missed practices by the Debutante/Beau may result in dismissal from participation in the ball. Any private make-up practices will be the financial responsibility of the Debutante/Beau and her parents.

I/We agree that the expenses incurred by Jack and Jill above that which is budgeted, and which are incurred at the request of the parents of most of the Debutante/Beaus, will be shared equally by the parents of all the Debutante/Beaus.

I/We further agree to pay Jack and Jill of America, Inc. National Harbor a non-refundable application fee in the amount of \$150.00, \$150 due on or prior to October 21,2022 I/We further agree to sell business and/or patron ads for the Ball's souvenir journal for a total value of \$1,500.00 minimum, and to sell Debutante/Beau Ball tickets (final number to be determined by December 2022). If less than the minimum required is turned in to Jack and Jill by me/us, the difference between the amount turned in and the minimum required shall be paid by me/us before participating in the Ball. I/We understand this is a legal, binding, and enforceable contract.
