We have finished our discussion on moles and Avagadro's Number. We are now learning how to determine the chemical formulae of a substance by applying the concept of the mole and Avagadro's number.

We are also continuing our work in scientific writing.

3:15-4PM

Last week students were asked to write a detailed procedure with a list of materials. This week they will be writing a lab report based on an online hydrate lab, where they will be assessed on their ability to write a good opening, including the proper scientific background on the phenomenon being investigated, and a closing which properly describes the result of the experiment.

Students will be completing a second lab after the Quarterly. It will be similar to the saltwater lab we conducted in November, where they will have to watch a video of an experiment being conducted. From that video they will have to write a full lab report using the rubric we have discussed in class.

If your student is struggling with the content, I would ask that you encourage your student to stay after class for the 20-minute small-group practice, or to attend my tutoring. I provide tutoring to all chemistry students from 4:00-5:00 PM on Mondays at https://meet.google.com/lookup/agh3cycrg7


