#### 2021-2022 SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT AND APPLICATION

#### INTRODUCTION

Soon after the Civil War, Congress established several all black Army regiments to serve in the southwestern territories. Cavalrymen assigned to these regiments became known as "Buffalo Soldiers", a name believed to have been started by Native Americans. The term is now used to refer to all black soldiers who served in the Army before the Armed Forces were desegregated.

Nationally, the Ninth and Tenth (Horse) Cavalry Association was established to recognize and educate the public on the accomplishments of these brave men. The Chaplain (Captain) Henry Vinton Plummer Chapter, located in Prince George's County Maryland, exists to further the objectives of the National Association while providing service to local communities.

#### ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR APPLICANTS

The Plummer Chapter of the Ninth and Tenth (Horse) Cavalry Association is pleased to announce that it is giving a \$1,000 scholarship award to one or more deserving Prince George's County students. This award is to be used to continue the education of the student(s) at an accredited, degree-granting institution of higher education. This is a call for all eligible students to apply for this one-time award.

#### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible, the student applicant must be a graduating senior at a high school in Prince George's County, Maryland. He or she must be able to prove acceptance at and must plan to attend an accredited, degree-granting institution of higher education of the student's choice.

A student selected for this award does not, necessarily, have to have the highest grade point average. However, the student's activities, essay, and letters of recommendation must show a history of leadership, resourcefulness, and hard work ethic.

#### Specifically, the student must:

- 1. Submit a completed application to the Plummer Chapter Scholarship Committee no later than May 30, 2022.
- 2. Show acceptance at an accredited, degree-granting institution of higher education;
- 3. Submit a copy of all official high school and other (if applicable) transcripts;
- 4. Submit a one-to-four page, double-spaced original essay (written by the STUDENT) on the topic listed below;
- Submit two letters of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, minister, employer, or community leader; and
- 6. Submit a recent (within the past two years) personal photo.

#### SCHOLARSHIP EVALUATION CRITERIA

The student will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- The student's overall grade point average must be at least a 2.0 based on a 4.0 scale;
- The student's contributions to his or her school and community; (the highest scoring in this area will be given to activities that reflect the student's field of interest, leadership abilities, work ethic, and/or concern for the health and well-being of the community);
- 3. The strength of the student's essay on the following topic:
  - Achievements and characteristics of "Buffalo Soldiers" worthy of admiration; and how I can apply this information to obtain my future goals.
- 4. The completeness of the student's application;

- 5. The financial need of the student as evidenced by proof of government aid to the student or the student's family. A student may also meet this criteria if they live in a single-parent household; and
- 6. The strength of an interview; if an interview becomes necessary.

#### **POINT ASSIGNMENT**

Points will be assigned to the applicant in the following manner:

#### **GRADE POINT AVERAGE:**

4.0 or higher 30 points

3.0 to 3.9 28 points

2.0 to 2.9 26 points

#### SCHOOL, COMMUNITY, CHURCH, INTERN, AND EMPLOYMENT ACTIVITIES:

Five or More Activities up to 20 points

Three or Four Activities up to 15 points

One or Two Activities up to 10 points

#### **ORIGINAL ESSAY:**

Essay up to 25 points

#### **COMPLETENESS OF APPLICATION:**

Letters of Recommendation 3 points

Proof of School Acceptance 3 points

Picture 2 points

Achievement of Deadline 2 points

#### **FINANCIAL NEED:**

**Financial Need** 

up to 15 points

#### **BONUS POINTS:**

Up to 5 additional points may be given to students in active military families, students showing outstanding service to the community, or students having great financial need.

#### **OVERALL SCALE**

The sum of all points will be determined for each applicant and each applicant will fall into one of the following categories. The Plummer Chapter Scholarship Committee will use these categories to determine the applicant(s) best qualified for the award. In the event that more than one applicant scores at the highest level, an in-person or phone interview may be required for the Committee to make their final selection.

90 and over Outstanding

70 to 89 Points Excellent

50 to 69 Points Satisfactory

#### NOTIFICATION, RECOGNITION, AND PAYMENT

#### Notification

Once the awardee is chosen by the Plummer Chapter Scholarship Committee, the recipient and the recipient's high school designated official(s) will be notified by mail or e-mail.

#### Recognition

The recipient may be recognized at a Plummer Chapter meeting and a Plummer Chapter member may be available to present the scholarship to the recipient at an appropriate school function, if such a function is held. A student's refusal to attend the Plummer Chapter Scholarship recognition meeting without a reason acceptable to the Plummer Chapter Scholarship Committee could result in withdrawal of the award.

#### **Payment**

The scholarship payment will be made in the following manner:

 To the Institution - The scholarship payment will be made directly to the accredited, degree-granting institution chosen by the recipient. The recipient must provide the Plummer Chapter Scholarship Committee with the school's applicable address, procedures, due dates, the student's ID number at the institution of higher education, and any other information necessary for payment to be made.

To the Recipient - The payment may be made directly to the recipient with proof that the recipient's entire tuition and board have already been paid in full by other means.
