
Using the "Advanced College Search" tool, you are able to narrow down your schools by selecting your personal preferences and a list of your college matches will appear after completing the question inquiries.



The "Colleges I'm Applying To" tab is ONLY to be used during your senior year!






Careers and Clusters I'm Thinking About



The "Favorite Career and Clusters" tool allows students to search professions and/or professional fields to find occupations they are interested in to add to their favorite career clusters list.






Careers and Clusters I'm Thinking About


Careers and Clusters I'm Thinking About












How to use Resume Tab


Your Portfolio summarizes all the information you have plugged into your profile, goals, career, academic, and college planning. This lets you access all the information you have put into your profile and accomplishments.


The "My Assessments" section of naviance showcases all the assessments you have taken and could still take. These assessments help you find what you are best at and help you complete other parts.












Goals

To assign goals on your naviance account select the "My Planner" choice in the top right of your screen.




STEP 2:


