BEFORE YOU BEGIN, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING EXPECTATIONS:

The National Honor Society recognizes students who achieve excellence in the areas of scholarship, character, leadership, and service. Students must be distinguished in ALL four of these areas.

Scholarship

A minimum of 3.2 cumulative weighted GPA is required to apply.

Service

Students who are applying to the National Honor society must have met specific Service Hours Checkpoints to be considered: 11th grade applicants must have earned at least 10 service hours to apply (and will be expected to complete 24 service hours by the last day of their junior year). 12th grade applicants must have earned at least 24 service hours to apply (and will be expected to complete 50 service hours by May 1st in order to be inducted officially into the National Honor Society and be recognized as an official member at the CMIT North Graduation).

A service/community activity is anything you have done to serve your community without receiving compensation (money, personal benefit or academic credit) for your actions. Service can include activities associated with school organizations as well as any community or religious organizations (non-profit organizations). If you use a club for your community hours, then you cannot double dip and use it towards your activities. For instance: if you are a member of the SGA and work to fulfill your duties, those hours would not count as community service as those duties are expected, not extra. Office or teacher aide positions are not considered service. Additionally, service hours must be documented (service hours forms submitted to Ms. Gaudette and officially logged on SchoolMax) prior to submitting your application to officially count on your application.

Leadership

You must show that you have been involved in extracurricular activities every year of high school and that you have risen to a leadership role in at least one of your activities.

A leadership position is any position in which you oversee or managing others. Serving in a leadership position means the activity described would not have occurred or would have been greatly impacted without your participation. These can be "traditional" positions such as a team captain or club officer. They can also be somewhat less obvious roles such as organizing a service activity or chairing a school committee. On your application, it is necessary to clearly describe your position and duties, so the faculty committee can understand your role.

Character

The selection committee (faculty council) will assess your character through a process involving analysis of your essay, the two recommendation letters submitted on your behalf, and forms you have compiled as part of this application.

The purpose of this application is for you to inform the selection committee of your history of leadership, character, scholarship and service. The committee is looking for consistent examples of leadership and service over an extended period of time.

YOUR TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION MUST ADDRESS TWO TOPICS: LEADERSHIP AND CHARACTER.

- One letter must be written by someone who can speak to your leadership
 and character outside of the classroom. This letter must be written by
 someone who is not a family member, family friend, neighbor, or a
 classroom teacher. This could be someone you worked with during your
 service hours, a manager at your place of work (if you work), a
 supervisor, a coach, a club adviser, a mentor, an administrator, etc.
- Your second letter must be written by a current or past CMIT teacher who
 can speak to your leadership and character inside of the classroom. These
 letters will be evaluated on the <u>specific examples</u> that depict your character
 and your leadership abilities.

The NHS advisor does not decide if you are accepted or denied. The Faculty Council makes that decision. Their decision is FINAL. There is not an appeals process, but students are invited to re-apply in the next evaluation period.
