- 4. File a **completed** application by 4:00 PM, **March 31, 2021**.
- 5. Include at least two letters of recommendation, but <u>not more than</u> three letters of recommendation, from a <u>member</u> of the <u>Teachers Association of Anne Arundel County</u> (TAAAC).
- 6. Not be a relative of a member of the Board of Directors of the Foundation for Educational Excellence listed below:
