Overview of Class:

Each class will every other day for the year. During that time students will be learning about the basic building blocks of Art and exploring them through their sketchbook assignments and at least four major art projects. Each project will be explored and created through an extensive unit. We will be doing a sculpture unit, a painting unit, a printmaking unit, and a drawing unit. After the completion of every project, students will reflect on their work/project before moving on.

Student Supplies:

Each student is responsible for bringing in a sketchbook for the class. This should be brought in on the second week our class meets. The sketchbook needs to be at least 7 x 10 and preferably mixed media paper.

Later in the year (after winter break) students will need a canvas to paint on. Please do not buy or bring it in yet. I will be sending out a mass email when the time comes.

Grading:

Overview: The goal of grading and reporting is to provide the students with feedback that reflects their progress toward the mastery of the indicators and objectives found in the Visual Art Curriculum Framework Progress Guide.

Class Work 50%

Students in this category will be graded on completion of studio projects, warm-ups, and daily participation. Studio projects will be graded based on a rubric that students will receive and review at the beginning and end of each project.

Independent Assignment 20%

Students in this category will be graded on any assigned homework assignments, which will be posted on Edmodo. Homework assignments will include written artist statements as well as sketchbook assignments.

Assessment 30%

Students in this category will be graded on participation in class critiques. Students will also be graded on written reflections done at the end of each studio project.
