

## Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP)

The Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP) assessments of Maryland College and Career Ready Standards (MCCRS) serve as an "educational GPS system," assessing scholars' current performance, and pointing the way to what students need to learn to be ready for the next grade level and, by high school graduation, for college and/or a career. It provides information on the scholar's progress towards proficiency on the Maryland College and Career Ready Standards.

MCAP is designed to give schools and teachers more information to improve instruction. Moreover, MCAP is designed to let parents know how their child is progressing academically. This more detailed information can head to strong engagement between parents and teachers.

The MCAP assessments are part of the state instructional program and students are required to participate.

Mathematics
May 10-13, 2022
4 sessions of 40 minutes each

English Language Arts (ELA)
May 17-20 2022
4 sessions of 70 minutes each

The test is designed to allow students to use the same computer-based tools that are used during instruction. Students with disabilities (IEP and 504's) will receive the same accommodations for the MCAP that they do for their regular instruction.


Ready Standards (MCCRS)

## Understanding the Scores

Students receive an overall score in each subject that falls into one of five performance levels. Performance levels range from Level 1 that indicates that a student has not yet met grade level expectations to Level 5 that indicates that the student has exceeded the grade level expectations
