Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP)

The **Maryland Comprehensive Assessment Program (MCAP)** assessments of **Maryland College and Career Ready Standards (MCCRS)** serve as an “educational GPS system,” assessing scholars’ current performance, and pointing the way to what students need to learn to be ready for the next grade level and, by high school graduation, for college and/or a career. It provides information on the scholar’s progress towards proficiency on the Maryland College and Career Ready Standards.

MCAP is designed to give schools and teachers more information to improve instruction. Moreover, MCAP is designed to let parents know how their child is progressing academically. This more detailed information can lead to strong engagement between parents and teachers.

The **MCAP** assessments are part of the state instructional program and students are required to participate.

English Language Arts/ Literacy

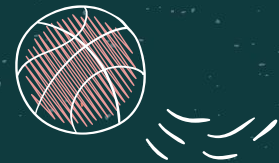
Scholars demonstrate their reading comprehension and literacy skills through responding to text-based questions and writing prompts.

Maryland College and Career Ready Standards (MCCRS)

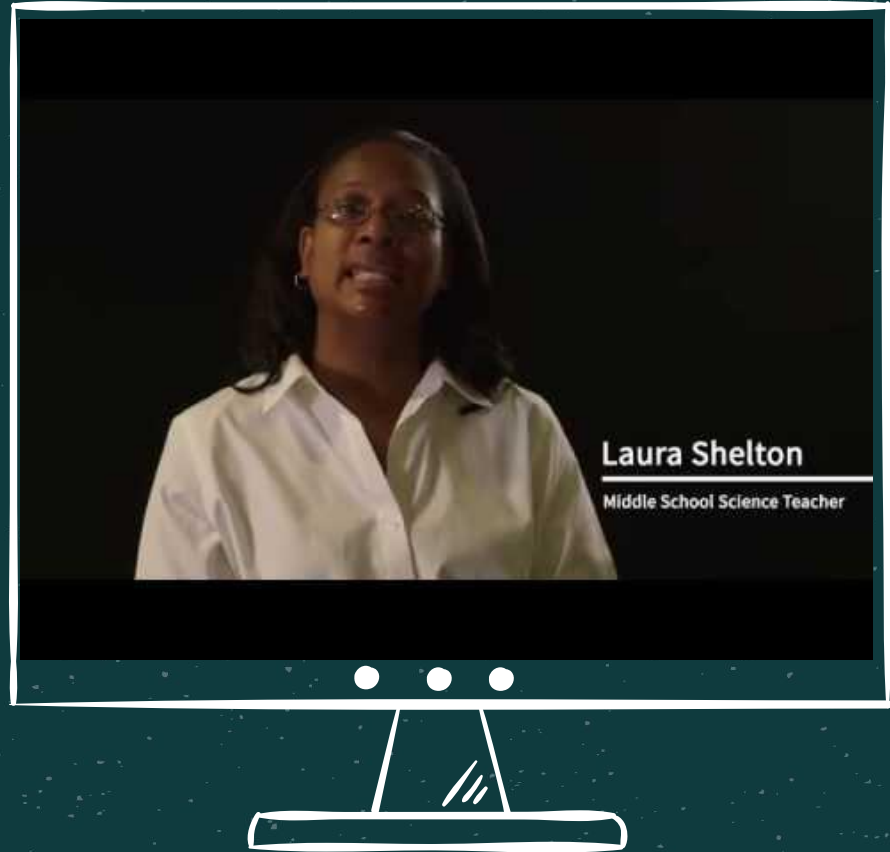
Students will be tested on skills across standards

Although standards are similar in 3rd-5th grade, the depth of knowledge varies by grades.



Understanding the Scores

Students receive an overall score in each subject that falls into one of five performance levels. Performance levels range from Level 1 that indicates that a student has not yet met grade level expectations to Level 5 that indicates that the student has exceeded the grade level expectations
