The Racial and Social Justice Committee of the Prince George's County Educators' Association has established a scholarship fund. Scholarships will be awarded to senior students who will graduate from Prince George's County public high schools in the 2021-2022 school year. Scholarships are a minimum of \$500.00 and will be given in recognition of outstanding academic performance, leadership qualities, and financial need.

The two types of scholarships offered are:

- 1. Merit
- 2. Merit/Need

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

You are eligible to apply if:

- You are currently a 12th-grade student who has attended Prince George's County Public High Schools for a minimum of two years.
- You are a graduate of a Prince George's County public high school by June 2022.
- You are accepted to accredited college/university, trade/technical school or post-secondary institution.
- You are in good academic standing with at least a "B" average or the equivalent in grades 9-12.
- You are a good citizen at school and in the community.
- You can provide evidence that you have exhibited leadership qualities in school and/or your community.

#### All applicants must submit the following:

- The attached two-page application
- A current resumé
- An up-to-date official transcript that includes grades received so far in applicant's senior year
- A recent professional or graduation photograph (non-returnable)- please do not provide a photocopied picture
- Three references (Two (2) from a teacher or counselor and One (1) from a member of your community)

#### **Deadline**

All information must be submited by April 9, 2022 (no exceptions).
