

How do I apply for federal aid?

- Fill out your FAFSA at <u>fafsa.gov</u>
 - Apply on or after October 1 but as early as possible to meet all deadlines.
 - School deadlines are listed on schools' websites.
 - Need help? Use the help functions within the FAFSA (including live chat) or call 1-800-433-3243.
 - Don't forget: watch for the confirmation page that says your FAFSA has been submitted, THEN log out.






