# **COMPETITION RULES**

Submit a picture (created with a graphic design software or hand-drawn) of your design, a brief written narrative up to 100 words and a video (MP4/not to exceed 2 mins) describing how your logo reflects the new CTE vision.

Submissions will be judged on the following criteria:

- ★ Relevance: Does the entry align with the vision for Maryland CTE?
- ★ Originality: Does the composition exhibit original design, creativity, and imagination?
- ★ Aesthetic Quality: Does the submission command attention? Does it display visual balance and color coordination? Do all elements work together to create a unified and appealing design?
- ★ Construction: Do the narrative and video submissions effectively explain the connection between the designed logo and the vision for CTE?
