Program Dates: **May 2 – July 18, 2020**

- A 10-week (Saturday's only) technology immersion program.
- Introduce & expose students to computer & network hardware so they understand the various hardware components used in computing technology.
- Introduce & expose students to current technology platforms & uses. Cybersecurity / Cloud Computing / IoT / Blockchain
- Expose the high school students to computer technology programs available at Prince George's Community College & Bowie State University (Segments of the program will be held at the Colleges and curriculum literature will be provided to the students).
- Expose students to IT industry professionals (Guest speakers) will provide first hand insight into the IT industry.
- Link the students that do extremely well to internship opportunities.

Participation criteria:

- ✓ Any Prince George's County High School student is eligible.
- ✓ Students have taken & passed Algebra I. Student high school transcript must be provided.
- ✓ Age or grade level requirement – High School Freshman / Sophomore / Junior / Senior.
- ✓ Students must commit to fulfilling all the requirements and attending all sessions of the program.
- ✓ Students accepted & their parents/guardians must attend a mandatory kick off meeting. April 4, 2020.
- ✓ The Youth Technology Immersion Program is a 10-week multi-track program. Some sessions will be held at: Prince George's Community College (Largo Campus) & some sessions will be held at Bowie State University (Bowie Campus).
