Maryland College Application Campaign (MCAC)

- A statewide effort to increase post-secondary education admission for high school seniors, providing access through the dissemination of ideas, development of practices, and technical assistance.
- Provides support to high school seniors, particularly first-generation students, students from low-income circumstances, unaccompanied homeless youth, foster care youth, students with disabilities, students enrolled in the Juvenile Services Education System, homeschool students, and undocumented students to pursue postsecondary opportunities.
- The MCAC provides guidance on State and federal financial aid programs.

WHAT IS THE MSFAA?

- The Maryland State Financial Aid Application (MSFAA) is for Maryland resident students who are ineligible for federal aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) (i.e., undocumented students).
- The MSFAA allows qualified children of undocumented immigrants, who qualify for in-state tuition under §15–106.8 of the MD Education Article, to apply and be considered for certain types of State need-based financial aid.
- The MSFAA is due March 1st annually.

WHAT IS THE MDCAPS?

- The Maryland College Aid Processing System (MDCAPS) is a comprehensive financial aid system that allows the State to process scholarship applications, and allocate funds more efficiently.
- All seniors must create an MDCAPS
 account to receive State financial aid.
