Internet registration is available for some programs once your account has been set up. We strongly encourage new customers to visit one our community centers to create an account. You must be registered to participate, unless a program listing states that no registration is required. Registration will be accepted through the first week of class if space is available. The City of Laurel Department of Parks and Recreation welcomes the participation of individuals with disabilities into all programs. The City will fully comply with the American with Disabilities Act in making reasonable accommodations to encourage participation.

Fees Checks are only accepted for certain activities. Persons paying City of Laurel property taxes pay resident fees. Fees include materials unless otherwise noted. No fee reductions will be made for missed classes. We are no longer able to accept discounts on contractual programs.

The City is able to accept credit cards at the community centers, pools or the Gude Mansion during operating hours. \$2.00 minimum credit card charge. Make all checks payable to: City of Laurel.

The City also offers vouchers for low income City resident families that may be used towards recreation programs for children, youth and teens with other agencies. 





This program is a partnership with PGCPS to provide an alternative to expulsion for students who are in violation of school drug policy.



The student and parent will attend a minimum of 2 sessions during which the student will be assessed for the level of use of substances, the impact it is having on the student's life and an exploration of the factors for underlying use. We provide recommendations and referrals for further treatment if necessary.
